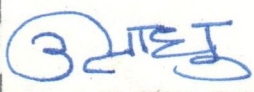
This Agreement is made on the 11th day of August, 2014 between The Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science (IACS) having its registered office at 2A & B Raja S. C. Mullick Road, Jadavpur, Kolkata – 700032 (hereinafter called IACS, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) of the **First Part**

AND

Asia Heart Foundation, having its registered office at 124, Mukundapur, E. M. Bypass, Kolkata, West Bengal 700099 **operating under the name of Rabindranath Tagore International Institute of Cardiac Sciences of the Second Part**

Now, therefore, it is hereby agreed between the parties as follows: -

1. The said agreement for cashless medical treatment would be effected from 11.08.2014 and will be valid for two (02) years for Inpatient Department (IPD) for all available disciplines/departments for the employees and pensioners and their dependants, and the scholars (self only), who are members of the

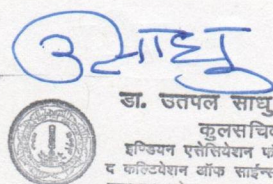

Contributory Medical Scheme (CMS) of IACS at Rabindranath Tagore International Institute of Cardiac Sciences (RTIICS) at 124, Mukundapur, E.M. Bypass, Kolkata-700099, **which is under Asia Heart Foundation.**

2. At the time of admission for any indoor treatment, the members of the scheme should produce valid Medical Identity Card affixed with the photographs of each member and their dependants, as issued by IACS.
3. It will be the responsibility of RTIICS to establish the identity of the patient before admission and the IACS authority is not liable to pay in cases of impersonation or treatment of ineligible persons.
4. For indoor treatments, IACS will issue an Authorization Letter confirming the beneficiary of the scheme and the admissibility of the bed charges and or ward in each case under CGHS rule.
5. In case of Emergency Admission, IACS will issue an Authorization Letter confirming the beneficiary of the scheme and the admissibility of the bed charges and or ward in each case under CGHS rule after receiving intimation in this regard from RTIICS or the patient party.
6. In emergency the hospital shall not refuse admission of the beneficiary or his family member and shall provide credit facilities to the patient whether the patient is a serving employee, scholar (self) or a pensioner availing CMS facilities of IACS on production of a valid Identity Card and the hospital shall submit the bill for reimbursement to IACS authority.
7. The definition of the term of "Emergency" shall be as defined in para 1.1.10 and para 12 of the agreement dated 26.11.2013 entered between Director, Central Government Health Scheme and Rabindranath Tagore International Institute of Cardiac Sciences, Kolkata, the extract of which is attached as Annexure-I to this agreement and will be a part of this agreement.
8. Treatment should be made on cashless basis i.e. no payment should be obtained from a member of the scheme at the time of admission/discharge. However, all payments towards the inadmissible items should be obtained in full from the member or the beneficiary as the case may be; IACS will have no responsibility in this regard. All indoor treatments should be charged in accordance to the approved CGHS Superspeciality Kolkata rates, as amended from time to time. However, if rate for any procedures is not available in the CGHS Superspeciality Kolkata rates Memorandum, the RTIICS shall charge at the existing rate of the hospital depending upon entitlement to ward.
9. Entitlements for Wards: CMS beneficiaries are entitled to facilities of Private, Semi-Private or General wards depending on their pay drawn in pay band/pension. The entitlements are as applicable to CGHS beneficiaries as mentioned below:

Sl. No.	Pay drawn in pay band/ basic pension	Entitlement
1	Up to Rs. 13,950/-	General Ward
2	Rs. 13,960 to 19,530/-	Semi-Private Ward
3	Rs. 19,540/-	Private Ward



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The entitlement will be amended from time to time as may be amended by CGHS. Other conditions associated with entitlements will be same as defined in para 15 of the agreement dated 26.11.2013 entered between Director, Central Government Health Scheme and Rabindranath Tagore International Institute of Cardiac Sciences, Kolkata, the extract of which is attached as Annexure-II to this agreement and will be a part of this agreement.

10. The outdoor treatment will, however, not be on cashless basis. The members shall pay the charges to the hospital and submit reimbursement claim to IACS. For outdoor patients, all radiological/ pathological/ clinical tests should be charged as per approved CGHS rates in Kolkata, as amended from time to time. However, if rate for any procedures is not available in the CGHS Superspeciality Kolkata Rate Memorandum, the RTIICS shall charge at the existing rate of the hospital. It will be the responsibility of RTIICS to obtain full payment from the patient party for providing outdoor treatment/ radiological/ pathological/ clinical tests, etc. IACS will have no responsibility in this regard.
11. The charges for the procedures should be restricted to the approved CGHS Super Speciality Rates along with general purpose for Kolkata, as amended from time to time.
12. It will be the responsibility of RTIICS to establish the identity of the patient before outdoor treatment/ radiological/ pathological/ clinical tests and the IACS authority is not liable to pay in cases of impersonation or treatment of ineligible persons.
13. For any implants, the difference amount between the ceiling limit of the implants as per the CGHS Superspeciality Kolkata rates, as applicable on the date of admission, and the existing market price should be settled with the patient party before admission/ treatment, as the case may be, and it will be the responsibility of the hospital administration to realize the difference amount from the patient party. IACS will not take the responsibility to realize the difference amount from the patient party and remit it to RTIICS. RTIICS shall exclude the amount already realized from the patient party, from their bill.
14. At the time of discharge of the patient, the hospital should obtain the signature/LTI of the Member of the Scheme and of the patient (if possible) on the documents of the treatment.
15. The Hospital agrees that any liability arising due to any default or negligence in providing or performance of the medical services shall be borne exclusively by the hospital who shall alone be responsible for the defect and/or deficiencies in rendering such services.
16. The Hospital agrees that during the In-patient treatment of the CMS beneficiary, the Hospital shall not ask the beneficiary or his attendant to purchase separately the medicines/sundries/equipment or accessories from outside and shall provide the treatment within the package rate fixed by the CGHS which includes the cost of all the items.
17. The definition of term of "Package Rate" shall be as defined in para 1.1.16, and para 14.3 of the agreement dated 26.11.2013 entered between Director, Central Government Health Scheme and Rabindranath Tagore International

Institute of Cardiac Sciences, Kolkata, the extract of which is attached as Annexure-III to this agreement and will be a part of this agreement.

18. The package rate, however, does not include expenses on telephone, tonics cosmetics/toiletries, etc. These are not part of the treatment regimen. Cost of these additional items, if provided with the prior consent of the patient, has to be settled with the patient, for which no reimbursement shall be admissible.
19. The Hospital shall not refer the patient to other specialist/other hospital without prior permission of IACS authorities.
20. Since, the treatment will be at RTIICS, all the bills will be forwarded to IACS by RTIICS on behalf of Asia Heart Foundation.
21. All payments by IACS should be made by Account Payee cheque/demand draft or through RTGS/online payment in favour of Asia Heart Foundation (RTIICS) having PAN No. AAATA6721A and TAN No. CALA04083C.
22. The bill for the treatment of the beneficiary of the scheme accompanied with report of all radiological / pathological test made for the purpose of treatment, copy of discharge certificate in each case along with Authorization Letter should be furnished to the IACS within fifteen days from the date of discharge of the patient. IACS will make the payment within the next 45 days from the receipt of the bill.
23. If asked for, RTIICS should provide Bed Ticket to IACS for its administrative requirements.
24. No service charge will be paid by IACS to RTIICS for providing indoor/outdoor treatments to the members of the CMS or their dependents.
25. Charges for Private Nurse/Aya, Ambulance, etc. during the period of stay at the hospital cannot be charged from IACS. Charges for these should be obtained from the patient party directly. IACS will have no responsibility in this regard.
26. If on the request of the beneficiary treatment is provided beyond the entitlement, the expenditure over and above the entitlement will to be borne by the beneficiary and charges for these should be obtained from the patient party directly. IACS will have no responsibility in this regard.
27. RTIICS shall allow IACS authority or its authorized representative and/or the IACS Medical Officer to visit the indoor/outdoor patient, if IACS deemed it necessary for administrative reasons.
28. The IACS authority shall not be responsible in any way for any negligence or misconduct of the Hospital and its employees for any accident, injury or damage sustained or suffered by any CMS beneficiary or any third party resulting from or by any operation conducted by and on behalf of the Hospital or in the course of doing its work or perform their duties under this Agreement or otherwise.
29. Arbitration: If any dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever shall arise between IACS and RTIICS upon or in relation to or in connection with or arising out of the agreement, shall be referred to for arbitration by the



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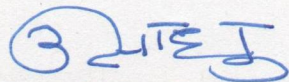
Director, IACS, who shall give written award of his decision to the parties. The decision of the Director, IACS shall be final and binding. The provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall apply to the arbitration proceedings. The venue of the arbitration proceedings shall be at Kolkata.

30. In respect of others matters not covered under this agreement, the guidelines/directions of CGHS as amended from time to time shall be applicable mutatis-mutandis.

31. This Agreement can be modified or altered only on written agreement signed by both the parties.

32. The Agreement can be terminated at any time by either parties by giving 1 (One) month notice.

1.1.7 "Coverage" shall mean the types of persons to be eligible as the beneficiaries of the Scheme to health services provided under the Scheme, subject to the terms, conditions and limitations.

1.1.8 "Diagnostic Center" shall mean the (Name of the Diagnostic Center) performing tests / investigations

1.1.9 "Imaging Centre" shall mean the (Name of the Imaging Centre) performing X-ray , CT Scan, MRI, USG, etc.,

1.1.10 "Emergency" shall mean any condition or symptom resulting from any cause, arising suddenly and if not treated at the earliest opportunity would be detrimental to the health of the patient or shall jeopardize the life of the patient.

1.1.11 "Empanelment" shall mean the hospital authorized by the CGHS for treatment purposes for a particular period.

1.1.12 "Hospital" shall mean the (Name of the Hospital) while performing under this Agreement providing medical investigation, treatment and the healthcare of human beings.

1.1.13 The meaning of General purpose hospital, Specialty Hospital and Super –specialty Hospital are as defined in para 'A' of E-Bid document.

1.1.14 "De-recognition of Hospital" shall mean debaring the hospital on account of adopting unethical practices or fraudulent means in providing medical treatment to or not following the good industry practices of the health care for the CGHS beneficiaries after following certain procedure of inquiry

1.1.15 "Party" shall mean either the CGHS or the Hospital and "Parties" shall mean both the CGHS and the Hospital .



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Health Services and such other categories of CGHS cardholders as notified by the Government.

In case of emergency the hospital shall provide credit to all CGHS beneficiaries.

11. MEDICAL AUDIT OF BILLS

There shall be a continuous Medical Audit of the services provided by the empanelled Private Hospital.

12. TREATMENT IN EMERGENCY

- In emergency the hospital shall not refuse admission or demand an advance payment from the beneficiary or his family member and shall provide credit facilities to the patient whether the patient is a serving employee or a pensioner availing CGHS facilities, on production of a valid CGHS card and the hospital shall submit the bill for reimbursement to the concerned Deptt. / Ministry / CGHS. The refusal to provide the treatment to bonafide CGHS beneficiaries in emergency cases without valid ground, would attract disqualification for continuation of empanelment.
- The following ailments may be treated as emergency which is **illustrative only and not exhaustive**, depending on the condition of the patient :



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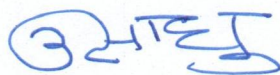

- ❖ Acute Coronary Syndromes (Coronary Artery Bye-pass Graft / Percutaneous, Transluminal Coronary Angioplasty) including Myocardial Infarction, Unstable Angina, Ventricular Arrhythmias, Paroxysmal Supra Ventricular Tachycardia, Cardiac Tamponade, Acute Left Ventricular Failure / Severe Congestive Cardiac Failure, Accelerated Hypertension, Complete Heart Block and Stoke Adam attack, Acute Aortic Dissection.
- ❖ Acute Limb Ischemia, Rupture of Aneurysm, Medical and Surgical shock and peripheral circulatory failure.
- ❖ Cerebro-Vascular attack-Stokes, Sudden unconsciousness, Head injury, Respiratory failure, decompensated lung disease, Cerebro-Meningeal Infections, Convulsions, Acute Paralysis, Acute Visual loss.
- ❖ Acute Abdomen pain.
- ❖ Road Traffic Accidents / with injuries including fall. Severe
- ❖ Hemorrhage due to any cause.
- ❖ Acute poisoning.
- ❖ Acute Renal Failure.
- ❖ Acute abdomen pain in female including acute Obstetrical and Gynecological emergencies.
- ❖ Electric shock.
- ❖ Any other life threatening condition.

13. REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING TREATMENT/PROCEDURE:

Every patient is required to produce a valid CGHS card.





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15. ENTITLEMENTS FOR VARIOUS TYPES OF WARDS

CGHS beneficiaries are entitled to facilities of private, semi-private or general ward depending on their pay drawn in pay band/ pension. These entitlements are amended from time to time and the latest order in this regards needs to be followed.

The entitlement is as follows:-

S.No.	Pay drawn in pay band/Basic Pension	Entitlement
1.	Upto Rs. 13,950/-	General Ward
2.	Rs. 13,960/- to 19,530/-	Semi-Private Ward
3.	Rs. 19,540/- and above	Private Ward

- Private ward is defined as a hospital room where single patient is accommodated and which has an attached toilet (lavatory and bath). The room should have furnishings like wardrobe, dressing table, bed-side table, sofa set, carpet, etc. as well as a bed for attendant. The room has to be air-conditioned.
- Semi Private Ward is defined as a hospital room where two to three patients are accommodated and which has attached toilet facilities and necessary furnishings.
- General ward is defined as a hall that accommodates four to ten patients.



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Treatment in higher Category of accommodation than the entitled category is not permissible.

• **16. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF HOSPITALS**

It shall be the duty and responsibility of the Hospital , at all times, to obtain, maintain and sustain the valid NABH Accreditation , recognition and high quality and standard of its services and healthcare and to have all statutory / mandatory licenses, permits or approvals of the concerned authorities under or as per the existing laws”.

17. NON ASSIGNMENT

The Hospital shall not assign, in whole or in part, its obligations to perform under this Agreement, except with the CGHS's prior written consent at its sole discretion and on such terms and conditions as deemed fit by the CGHS. Any such assignment shall not relieve the Hospital from any liability or obligation under this agreement

18. HOSPITAL'S 'S INTEGRITY AND OBLIGAITONS DURING AGREEMENT PERIOD

The Hospital is responsible for and obliged to conduct all contracted activities in accordance with the Agreement using state-of-the-art methods and economic principles and exercising all means available to achieve the performance specified in the Agreement. The Hospital is obliged to act within its own authority and abide by the directives issued by the CGHS. The Hospital is responsible for managing the



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1.1.16 "Package rate" is defined as lump sum cost of inpatient treatment/ day care for which a patient has been referred by competent authority or CGHS to Hospital. This includes all charges pertaining to a particular treatment/ procedure including:

- Registration charges,
- Admission charges.
- Accommodation charges (includes diet provided to patient),
- Operation charges
- Injection charges,
- Dressing charges,
- Doctor/consultant visit charges,
- ICU/CCU charges,
- Monitoring charges,
- Transfusion charges,
- Anesthesia charges,
- Operation theatre charges,
- Procedural charges/surgeon's fee,
- Cost of surgical disposables and all sundries used during hospitalization,



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- Cost of medicines.
- Related routine and essential investigations,
- Physiotherapy charges etc
- Pre-anesthetic check up
- Any other charges levied during stay under package days duration.
- The above list is an illustrative one only.

The package rate, however, does not include expenses on telephone, tonics, cosmetics / toiletries, etc. These are not part of the treatment regimen. Cost of these additional items, if provided with the prior consent of the patient, has to be settled with the patient, for which no reimbursement shall be admissible.

- In order to remove the scope of any ambiguity on the point of package rates, it is reiterated that the rate quoted for a particular procedure must be inclusive of all sub-procedures and all related procedures to complete the treatment procedure. The patient shall not be asked to bear the cost of any such procedure/item.
- Implants shall be allowed as per CGHS ceiling rate or as per actual, whichever may be less or as per actual, if there is no CGHS rate.

1.1.17 "Specialized treatment" shall mean the treatment in a particular specialty.



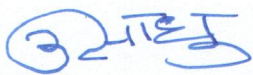

14. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 14.1 All investigations regarding fitness for the surgery shall be done prior to the admission for any elective procedure and are part of package. For any material / additional procedure / investigation other than the condition for which the patient was initially permitted, would require the permission of the competent authority.
- 14.2 The hospital shall verify the CGHS card and the CGHS/ Department is not liable to pay in cases of impersonation or treatment of ineligible persons.
- 14.3 The package rate shall be calculated as per the duration specified in the tender document under the 'treatment requirements'. No additional charge on account of extended period of stay shall be allowed if that extension is due to infection on the consequences of surgical procedure or due to any improper procedure and is not justified.
- 14.4 The procedure and package rates for any diagnostic investigation, surgical procedure and other medical treatment for CGHS beneficiary under this Agreement shall not be increased during the validity period of this Agreement.
- 14.5 The empanelled Hospital shall provide services only for which it has been empanelled by CGHS at rates that shall be fixed by Central Government Health Scheme from time to time and shall be binding.
- 14.6 The Hospital shall intimate all instances of patients admitted on the basis of the Authority letter issued by the CGHS authorities in the prescribed format within one working day through fax / email (the number of which shall be notified) followed by post to CGHS / BCA.

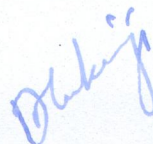

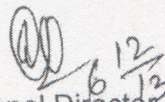

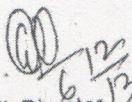
