Essential Qualifications:

Candidate should have a PhD degrees in life sciences and good academic records in BSc and Masters, and interest and dedication in research related to zebrafish system. Research Experience in the area of zebrafish system. The candidate should have published articles in peer reviewed Journals.

Desirable Qualifications:

Knowledge and experience in handling the Zebrafish Stand-alone aquarium system, Rearing, breeding and embryo handling. Candidate should have adequate information about the fish type and common disease with zebrafish and experience in the collection of wild zebrafish. Should have working knowledge of In-vivo staining of the embryo, Histology, Histo-chemistry, Ion Chromatography, HPLC, GC-MS.

Research Area: Lipid metabolism and toxicology in zebrafish model system

Nationality: Applicant should be an Indian citizen.

Fellowship: As per rules of IACS. No TA will be admissible for attending the interview.

Additional Responsibility: Maintaining the zebrafish facility 6 days a week.

Tenure: Up to 2 years subjected to 6 monthly satisfactory performance. Every 6 months the performance will be evaluated for the extension of the fellowship.
