The candidate should have B.Sc. and M.Sc. degree in physics with at least 55% of marks.	Past research experience in experimental condensed matter physics/ electronics/ device physics or related areas with impressive research publications in reputed journals and impressive academic track record.

Job Description: Supervision of UG and PG research laboratories in the School of Physical Sciences of IACS, laboratory instruction and guidance to UG and PG students, maintenance of non-trivial research facilities of common interest of the school and research work as assigned/ approved by the School Chair.

Tenure: This position is temporary (initially for one year and can be extended for another year based on satisfactory performance). The candidate will have no right to claim (explicit or implicit) any post in the institute.

Fellowship: As per rules of IACS

Selection procedure: Applicants will be shortlisted on the basis of merit. Only shortlisted candidates will be communicated via email and called for an interview for the final selection. Merely satisfying the eligibility criteria does not guarantee that a candidate will be shortlisted for interview. IACS holds full right of choosing a candidate and even not selecting any, in case suitable applications are not received.
